Trainer Cycle and League Challenge Information

Season Schedule

Pokemon has changed the way we conduct our season schedules. The trainer cycle will now be divided up into quarters. We are now in the new trainer cycle and in what we call Q4. Seasons will now be conducted each month. This changes our season from 6 weeks to 4 weeks per seasons. The new seasons are as follows.

Nature Season - November 1st - November 30th Tech Season - December 1st - December 31st Break Season - January 1st - January 31st

We will still have league promo and code cards for casual play. We also have an option for a competitive track. Information later in this issue and given out at league as we continue forward.

League Challenges

With the new changes we will now have possibly 12 league challenges per year over 8 league challenges per year. Prizes at our league challenges will still need to be determined. These will still remain Premier Events that will you be able to gain Champion Points.

The League Challenge Schedule is as follows.

November 21st - Expanded

December 19th - Standard

January 16th - Expanded

These dates are subject to change. We will notify you of any changes.

These LCs will be held at the Captain Hampton Memorial Library. Registration will be 930a -1030a. The cost will be free for all players.

As we move forward you will notice changes in the way the league will be conducted. We ask for your patients as we work with Pokemon in ensuring we are compliant with our sanctioned status with Pokemon. The league season prizes will change to some degree. We feel this will be exciting new changes. We hope that you continue to have fun and join us in this new frontier of Pokemon.

We hope to be able to assist players in obtaining an online Pokemon Trainer account at league in the near future. In order to recieve certain prizes such as Pokeballs, you will need to print off a Pokamon ID from your traininer account or verify your online Pokemon Trainer account with the league leaders.

An online Pokemon Trainer account provides a way to connect Pokémon players all around the world. With the Pokémon Trainer Club account, players can enjoy some member-exclusive benefits.

By creating a new account you can earn trainer tokens, be a part of organized Pokémon play, get the latest Pokémon news, and customize your trainer appearance and so on. Creating a new account is simple, easy and convenient.

When Hoopa is in Pokémon Omega Ruby or Pokémon Alpha Sapphire, it can transform into the powerful Hoopa Unbound!

Changes To Our Trainer Cycle

Our Pokémon Leagues are officially sanctioned by Pokémon, USA, inc. Play Pokemon the divison of Pokemon that sanctions Pokemon Leagues, regulates how we conduct our league sessions. We are now in our new league cycle. The league cycle will now be divided into Quarters during the year. Meaning that we will have three seasons, one per month, three months that make up the quarter. The season starts at the beginning of the month and ends on the last day of the month. We will also have one league challenge per month. Instead of 8 league challenges we have a potential of 12 league challenges per year.

The league may choose a competative or casual play track, our league (Easley and Anderson) will continue on a casual play track with a few changes. Changes may occur each quarter, depending on the direction of Play Pokemon. This quarter there are four Pokeball charms per age group that can be awarded at the end of the quarter. They will be as follows.

Master Ball

Casual Play – The player who finishes (Wins) the most matches wins this achievement. (There will be about 24 games for the entire guarter.)

Luxury Ball

Casual Play – The player who has the best all-foil deck or shiny Pokemon team, as voted by their fellow league players, wins the achievement. (Decks will have a theme and requirements choosen each quarter. Example 30 card show decks, one type, etc.)

Premier Ball

Casual Play - The player who brings the most new

players to League wins this achievement

Poké Ball

Casual Play – The player who best represents the Spirit of The Game, as determined by the League

assigned League Leaders wins this achievement.

These Pokeballs will be awarded at the end of the quarter if, you have achieved the Pokeball and you have an online Pokemon Trainer Account. You must provide us with a Pokemon ID printed from Pokemon.com or confirm with the league leader your online account is active. You must have an online Pokemon Trainer Account to be eligible for these Pokeballs. One Pokeball will be awarded to the one player who wins the achievements. We no longer will use score cards for each individual. We will now have leader boards to be posted at the league to track these achievements. We will still be giving out league promo and online cards for participation in the season. You do not need an online trainer account to recieve these promos.


