Pokemon Scholarships

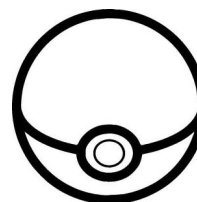

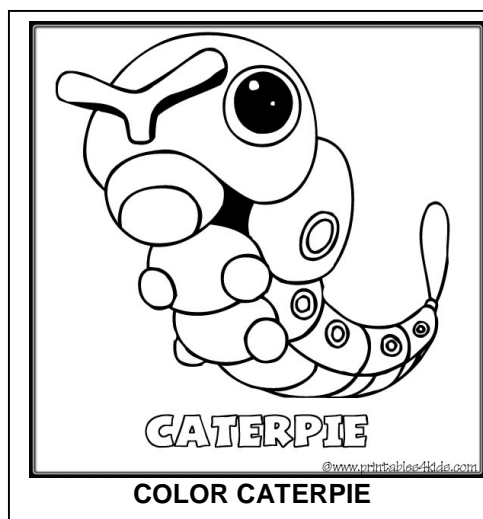
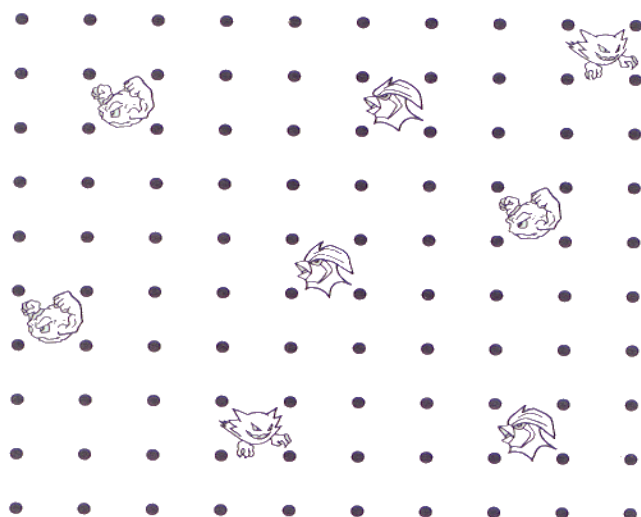

Fun Stuff



Two players. Take turns drawing a straight line between 2 dots to make a square. As you complete a square put your initials in it and take another turn. Count 3 points with each square containing Pidgeotto, 2 points for Geodude, 1 point for each square with your initials. Subtract 3 points for each square with Haunter. The player with the most points wins.
