Players Tracks

Master Ball Track - Report winning games to the league leaders so it can be reported on the leader boards. February starts a new quarter and the player tracks are reset.

Luxary Ball Track - Build a 30 card playable deck with all shiny or as many shiny cards as you can. Present it to the league leaders. We will let players vote on the card decks at the end of the quarter.

Premier Ball Track - Bring a friend new to Pokemon. Bring

as many new players as you can to the league. Check in with the league leaders to verify how many new players you brought to league.

Poke Ball Track – The player who best represents the Spirit of The Game, as determined by the League Owner or assigned League Leaders wins this achievement.

<u>Masters Players</u> - Participate in the weekly tournaments as the happen.

Check in every week with the league leaders and verify your trainer accounts. When you check in you will get the season promo and/or code cards as available.

An online Pokemon Trainer account provides a way to connect Pokémon players all around the world. With the Pokémon Trainer Club account, players can enjoy some member-exclusive benefits.

By creating a new account you can earn trainer tokens, be a part of organized Pokémon play, get the latest Pokémon news, and customize your trainer appearance and so on. Creating a new account is simple, easy and convenient.

We have found an app and related website to the app that list cards in all Pokemon sets from Basic through Break Point, including McDonald's sets. They list English and Japanese sets. The app and website list card values from various websites. The website will also let you view value history of the card you are searching. The website also allows you to mark the cards you own in your collection and generates card list to track cards you are looking to collect.

The app and website is called Pokellector. The app can be found in the Google play store, iTunes, and the website can be found at http://pokellector.com. Registration at the Pokellector website is free.


